

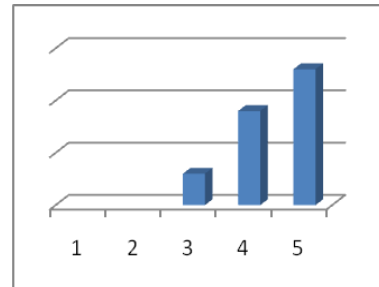

5 = Strongly Agree

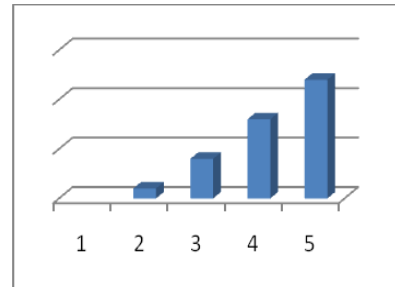
...INTRINSIC VALUE: Steven Spear's material had essential value in a wide variety of circumstances and conditions.

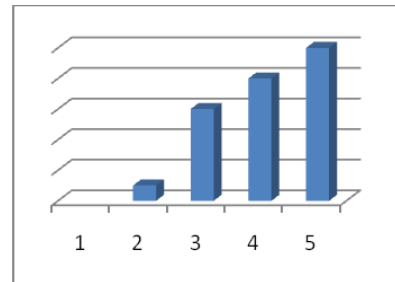
...RELEVANCE: Steven Spear's material was pertinent to your current needs and challenges.

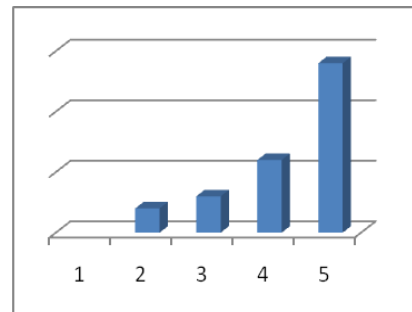
...APPLICABLE: Steven Spear's material can be readily applied.
